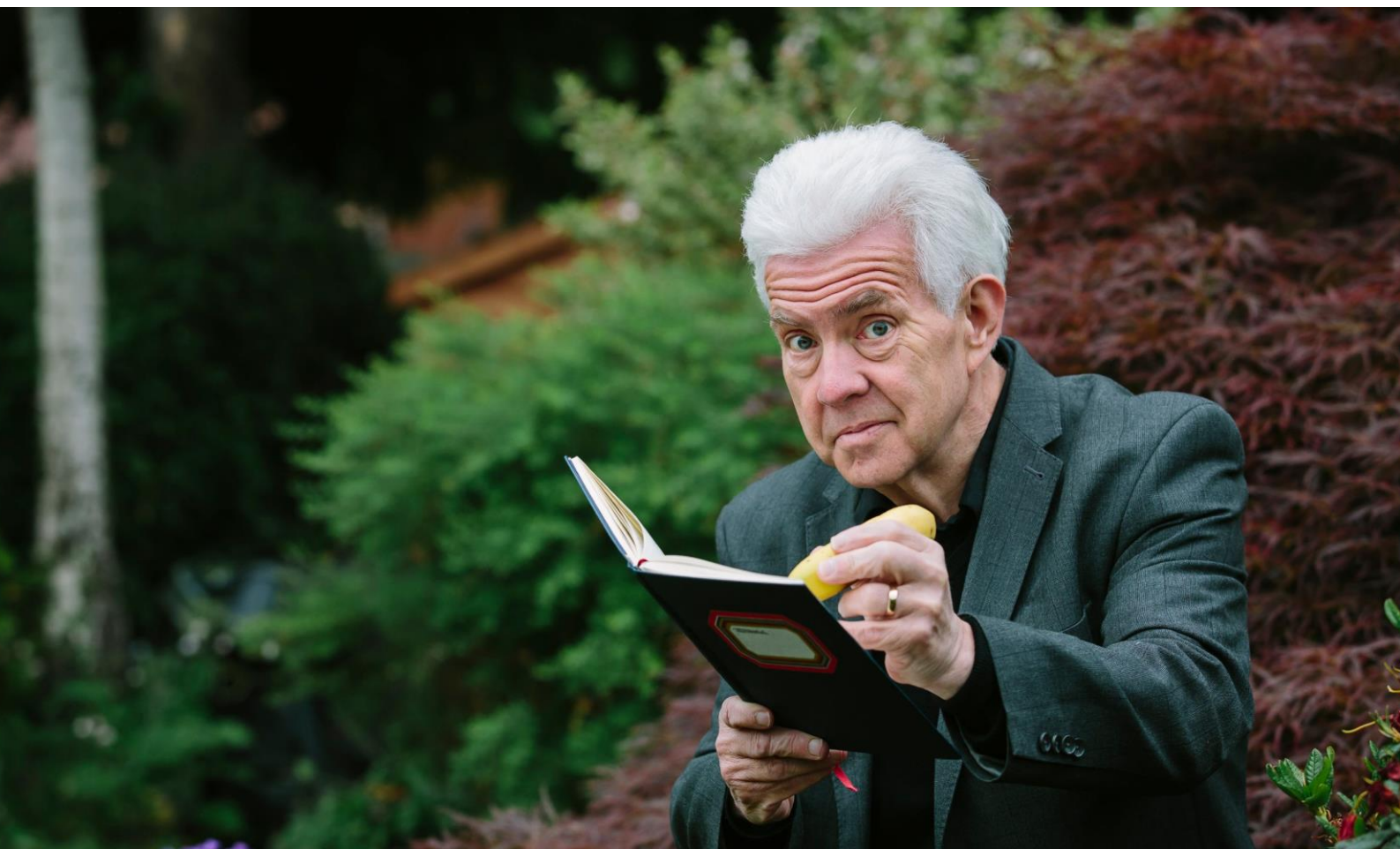

Sites are step free but some have some uneven ground. We will walk around the sites; these are small areas. We will stand most of the time. There is some public seating available. There are toilets at the station but not at the other sites.

Ferry Boat inn/Parish Church. Meet on the corner of Ferryboat lane and Church street –the nearest postcode is S64 0EX.

Mexborough train station is on Station Road; the postcode is S64 9AQ. Meet at the main station entrance.

Castle Hill Park. The park is next to Castle Hills Avenue, between Doncaster Road and Church Street. Meet at the Cenotaph monument by the entrance on Doncaster Road, the nearest postcode is S64 0LU.
